Catellani & Smith

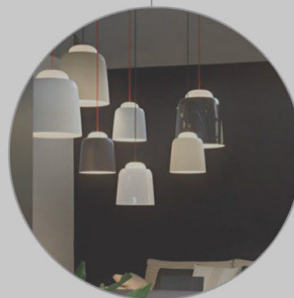
